· On a motion by Councilwoman Romito, 2<sup>nd</sup> by Councilwoman Muth and carried, The Board adopted **Resolution #18 of 2021. SUBJECT: Resolution for Senior & Low Income Disabled**

“**WHEREAS**, The Town Board of the Town of Jewett, in recognition of the Governor's Executive Order dated December 26, 2021 No. 11.1;

**WE HEREBY RESOLVE THE FOLLOWING:**

That subdivisions 7, 7-a and 8 of section 459-c of the Real Property Tax Law, and subdivisions 5, 5-a, 5-b, 5-c and 6 of section 467 of the Real Property Tax Law detail annual renewals;

**WE HEREBY**, direct the assessor to grant exemptions pursuant to such sections on the 2022 assessment roll to all property owners who received that exemption on the 2021 assessment roll;

**THEREBY**, dispensing with the need for renewal applications from such persons, and further dispensing with the requirement for assessors to mail renewal applications to such persons. Providing also that the assessor may require a renewal application to be filed when he or she has reason to believe that an owner who qualified for the exemption on the 2021 assessment roll may have since changed his or her primary residence, added another owner to the deed, had a significant income change, transferred the property to a new owner, or died.

**NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED**, that the Town Board of the Town of Jewett hereby adopts this resolution”.
