The special meeting of the Jewett Town Board was held on Wednesday, November 5, 2014. Deputy Supervisor James Pellitteri called the meeting to order at 6:04 P.M. Present were Board Members Michael McCrary, Nathan Miles and William Trach. Also present was the town clerk. Public present was Michael Flaherty.

On a motion by Councilman McCrary, 2nd by Councilman Trach and carried, the Town Board proposed that Deputy Supervisor James Pellitteri take the chair. Deputy Supervisor James Pellitteri recused himself from voting.

Councilman McCrary made a motion, 2nd by Councilman Miles and carried to open the public hearing at 6:06 P.M. regarding the preliminary budget. Michael Flaherty took the floor and started out by complementing the board on doing a great job with the budget. He had one issue that he wanted to bring to the attention of The Board and that was the worker compensation line item that had gone up from \$18,000 to \$40,000. The Board explained that they were aware of this and unfortunately this amount is predetermined by Greene County. Mr. Flaherty recommended that they shop around to get the best broker price. Deputy Supervisor Pellitteri said that they are in the process of doing that.

On a motion by Councilman McCrary, 2nd by Councilman Miles and carried, the public hearing was closed at 6:14 P.M.

Councilman McCrary made a motion, 2nd by Councilman Trach and carried to adjourn the meeting at 6:15 P.M.
